ADVANCED TRAUMA LIFE SUPPORT (ATLS) TRAINING PROGRAM

"FROM CLASSROOM LEARNING TO EMERGENCY RESPONSE"

RV College of Nursing successfully conducted a two-day Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) Training Program on 20th and 21st July 2026 in the Simulation Labs and Classrooms. The program was designed to strengthen nursing students' knowledge, clinical judgment, and practical competencies in emergency and trauma care.

The training commenced with sessions on Recognition of the Critically Ill using the National Early Warning Score (NEWS), Triage Principles, and Trauma Nursing H.A.B. (Hemorrhage, Airway and Breathing). Students were further introduced to C.D.E. assessment—Circulation, Disability and Exposure, supported by airway and trauma moulage demonstrations. A dedicated session on healthcare communication emphasized effective interaction with patients, relatives, and healthcare teams during emergencies.



ACADEMIC & SKILL DEVELOPMENT CORNER

The demonstration sessions provided opportunities for students to explain concepts, demonstrate clinical procedures, use audio-visual aids, engage learners through questioning, and provide opportunities for return demonstration. Faculty members observed the sessions and provided constructive feedback on content delivery, communication, organization, time management, and classroom interaction.

“HEALTHY FAMILIES, STRONGER COMMUNITIES: WORLD POPULATION DAY 2026”

Theme: “Realizing the hopes and aspirations of young people – today and for the future.”

The Department of Community Health Nursing, RV College of Nursing, observed World Population Day 2026 through a community health education programme at Yelachenahalli Primary Health Centre, Bengaluru, on 9 July 2026.

A health talk on “Planned Parenthood, Birth Spacing and Safe Motherhood” was conducted for eligible couples, antenatal and postnatal mothers, and community members. Participants were educated on the importance of family planning, responsible parenthood, adequate birth spacing, and maternal and child health. Information regarding temporary and permanent contraceptive methods and family welfare services available at the PHC was also provided.

An interactive discussion enabled participants to clarify doubts and misconceptions related to contraception and reproductive health. The programme enhanced awareness and encouraged informed reproductive health choices and utilization of available healthcare services, contributing to healthier families and communities.
